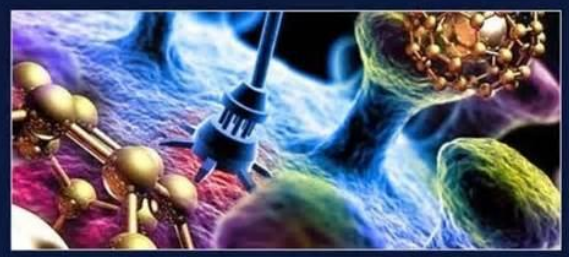
Topic 1. Nanotechnology and the environment - 13 September

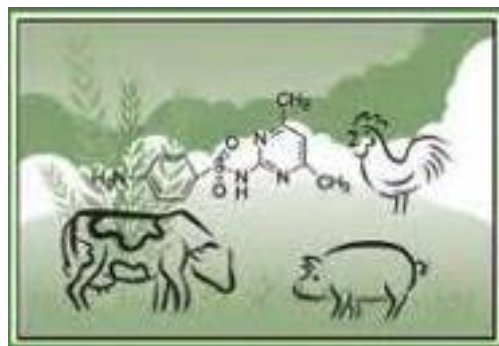
Topic 2. DNA in the Dutch Delta - 27 September
